Attendance: We aim for 100% attendance. We know anything below 97% has an impact on achievement - below 93% attendance means on a 50% chance of achieving 5 good GCSE results! From August, the government will make changes to the attendance policies and procedures that all schools must follow.


The important facts:

Parents can no longer be given term time leave for students - each parent will receive an £80 fine per child. If they take a second leave, it will be £160 and a third will be a court appearance (£2500 fine or even imprisonment)

The same steps for absence from school (more than 5 days) and lates. Parents must inform us of absence and provide relevant (medical) evidence.

Jewellery

- Watches (ALL SMARTWATCHES AND GLASSES TO BE HANDED IN WITH PHONES)
- 1 pair of stud earrings only (to be worn in the ear lobes only)
- Religious pendants/bracelets worn under clothing
- Only school council or reward badges are permitted to be worn
- No nose studs or other facial piercings to be worn, retainers are provided.
- No tattoos



Procedure for Mobile Phones

Students are allowed to bring mobile phones to school but they *must be*:

- Switched off inside school
- Handed to the Pastoral team before school (or when you arrive to school if late)
- Collected at the end of the school day and only switched on when you have left the site.
- Year 7 are NOT allowed smartphones

There is no excuse for having a phone on you*, if found, it will be confiscated and held until the end of the week (or, if it is a Friday, until Monday after school).

At this point, a parent must come in to collect it from the front office.

Items not to be brought to school

Items students **should not** bring to school and will be provided when necessary. Any restricted items will be confiscated and may be disposed of:

- Scissors
- Pencil sharpeners
- Compasses
- Spray bottles or cans (e.g. perfumes/deodorants)
- Glass

This is for health and safety reasons.



Banned items

Other items not to be brought in:

- Energy or fizzy drinks
- Any form of vape or cigarette (this will lead to suspension)
- Chewing gum (automatic behaviour point and detention)
- Large bags of sweets
- Crisps
