Dear Parents/Guardians of Year 11 students,

I hope this letter finds you all well and that your child is making the most of the time they have following the end of Year 11 and the start of their post-16 education. I am writing to give you more information on the current plan for results day and the appeals process.

Results Day:

GCSE results day is **Thursday 24**th **August**. From 9.00am students will be able to come into school via the side gate of the sports hall In Rectory Road to collect their results in person.

Exams office staff will be on hand to give out the results envelopes and answer any queries you may have. Ms Ford, our Aspirations & Destinations coordinator and a careers advisor, will also be available to support any students with post-16 questions.

Students who are not able, or do not wish to attend school must provide an A4 Stamped Addressed envelope (large Letter stamp) and we will post your results out to you.

If a family member is coming to collect your results, you will need to inform me by email: i.pascal@littleiflord.org, please state the name of the person coming and ensure they bring Photo ID on the day (ie passport or driving licence)

GCSE 2023 Appeals Process:

Should a student not be happy with a grade they receive, then they have the opportunity to appeal their grade if they meet the eligibility criteria. It is important to note that an appeal may result in a grade being lowered, staying the same, or going up. Therefore, if a student puts in an appeal and their grade is lowered, they will receive the lower mark.
