The Youth Empowerment Fund, an innovative fund that helps young people from low-income families achieve their ambitions by removing where ever possible, small financial barriers which may be impeding young people's success. The Fund is unique from other funding streams or grants because young people are invited to apply directly on their own behalf or with support from a parent / carer or professional to secure assistance across a broad range of initiatives or opportunities to support them to begin to think about and shape their own future.

The aim of the Youth Empowerment Fund is to:

- Support young people's aspirations
- Remove small financial barriers to success
- Make Newham the best place for a child/young person to be young and grow up

With the Youth Empowerment Fund, young people can apply for up to £2,500 to help fund their ambitions. Whether it's buying sports equipment, pursuing higher education, this Fund is designed to give young people the financial support they need to reach their potential.

The impact of the Youth Empowerment Fund has been significant. For many young people from low-income families, financial barriers can be a major obstacle to achieving their ambitions. With the help of this Fund, they're able to overcome those barriers and pursue their dreams.

Please see some examples below of young people who have benefited from the Youth Empowerment Fund:

"Anybody eligible for the Youth Empowerment Fund, try your luck. Everybody needs that one edge in life to help them.
