


Uniform Expectations - Fair Warning

- After half-term students will be given 0 warnings about uniform.
- If any part of a student's uniform is incorrect they will receive a behaviour point immediately.
- Students are expected to be in the correct uniform from the moment they arrive

at the entrance gate in the morning until they leave the premises after school.

- Every member of staff that sees a student in incorrect uniform will give that student a behaviour point.
- Jewellery (inc. nose piercings) will be confiscated. Refusal to hand over prohibited items (e.g. jewellery) will be escalated inline with our policy.
