Dear Parent / Carer,

Following my letter on Friday, 21st April, please see the below information regarding the Year 11 students' strategy for the day.

I can confirm that Year 11 will be required to attend school as usual on Thursday, 27th April. If they do not attend, this will be counted as an unauthorised absence.

English, Maths and Science are the lessons that will take place, and students will follow their regular timetable, except for the core PE lesson on that day. The day will be shortened from 8:20 am until 12:35 pm as we will not run the core PE lesson. For the students with Science periods 5 & 6, these lessons will now occur during periods 3 & 4 instead of the core PE lesson.

Please support your Year 11 students to attend, as we are only a few weeks away from the start of the examinations. With teaching days lost to Bank Holidays, we must make the most of the time we have left.

As previously stated, students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 will be asked to remain at home, and work will be provided on Google Classroom.
