Dear Year 11 students,

We hope that you and your families are well and have been able to enjoy the summer period. We are writing to you now to update you regarding how to collect your GCSE results and to let you know about next steps.

As you will have seen in the media this week, this year's results will now be based on the Centre Assessed Grades (CAGs)or the Calculated Grade (whichever is higher). The CAGs were based upon the data and results the school held on you including mock results; unit tests and any coursework. At Little Ilford, teachers went through an extensive period of moderation to ensure that the grades awarded were fair, accurate and honest. It was rigorously moderated by departments and SLT in accordance with guidelines laid out by Ofgual.
