Aims

- 1) Close literacy gaps by the end of Year 7
- 2) Encourage active, regular reading
- 3) Close basic numeracy gaps by the end of Year 7

Strategy	Impact
Literacy and dyslexia testing software.	Students were tested on entry and in September allowing us to swiftly identify individual needs and design bespoke interventions for them. This data was tracked in Go4Schools and all Year 7s were tracked throughout the year.
Staff training for 'Exact' and 'Everyone can Read'	Staff training allowed us to deliver new reading programmes effectively meaning that all the Year 7 students who needed support received it.
Staff Costs to deliver Intervention sessions before and after school.	Staff delivering the booster sessions produced excellent results with their students resulting in the following levels of progress and attainment. 75% of all Year 7 students finished the year 'on track' in English 98% of all Year 7 students finished the year 'on track' in Maths
Intervention Manager post created	The Intervention Manager managed the 'flow' of students into sessions and communicated regularly with the teaching team. This facilitated an ongoing dialogue between herself and teachers with regards to teaching strategies and intervention sessions. This flow of information resulted in the teaching team improving their practice and embedding the work already done in small groups. As a result, the progress of the students accelerated.
