Your first point of contact for any issues is your **form tutor**.

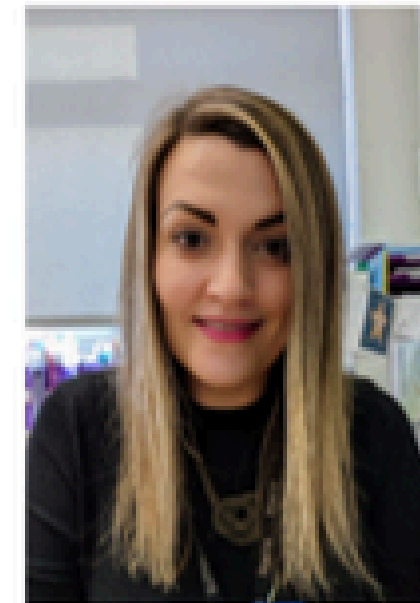

Rooms and Corridors

The timetable will show the rooms for each of your lessons. Each room has a code made up of two letters and two numbers – this tells you where to find the room.

Letters

The two letters of the room number outline where the room is.

- CM is Communicate – the **ORANGE** corridor
- EX is Explore and EV is Evaluate – the **GREEN** corridor
- CR is Create, DS is Discover and PF is perform – the **PURPLE** corridor

Numbers

The two numbers show the actual room and whether it is upstairs or downstairs.

- Rooms that start with 0 are downstairs
- Rooms that start with 1 are upstairs

For Example:

EV11 is in the green corridor and upstairs

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones are **not allowed** to be **seen or used** in school.
