Dear Parents / Carers

In order to make our organisation as efficient as possible, improve our communication with parents and enhance our student experience, we are changing our MIS (management information system) and catering providers from April 2024.

We are phasing in changes in order to ensure that everything goes smoothly. The timeline on page 4 of this guide provides an overview of what we will be bringing online and when. For example, there will be a period of time where we are running both Bromcom/MCAS and Class Charts at the same time, but the intention is to have everything running via Bromcom from September 2024 (with payments for class trips and visits the last thing to come online by April 2025).

The following pages explain what Bromcom and MCAS are, what parents need to know and do with regard to payment for school dinners/lunches and what to expect from our new catering partner, Mellors. There is a parent checklist with actions required at the end of this document.

I am sure that the changes we are implementing will go smoothly and you will see a marked improvement in the coming months. As ever, we welcome your feedback as we implement new systems.

As part of the ongoing effort to improve the information and communication Longbenton High School provides, we are changing our management information system (MIS). Our MIS underpins all aspects of the school's data processing systems. From Easter we will be using **Bromcom** at Longbenton High School. Class Charts will still be in place for the remainder of the 2024 summer term, but the intention is to phase this out by September 2024, so that everything is in one place: payments for school lunches; payments for trips; timetable, homework and detention information and so on.

Bromcom is the school's MIS (management information system) and is the central piece of software in the day to day running of the school. '**MCAS**' stands for My Child at School and is the name of the parent/carer view of our published data on both desktop and the app.

This system will replace ParentPay as a means of paying for lunches from April 2024. In the first instance, we will be using MCAS for school lunch payments only. This is due to the fact that our catering provider is also switching in April from North Tyneside to Mellors.

We will also have a **new till system that uses biometric facial recognition** from 15th April. Please see the Mellors section within this guide for more details on what this means and how to give your parental consent.

We have not enabled all the features in Bromcom yet, so there may be features mentioned in help guides that you find online that are not visible in your Bromcom/MCAS view. We will publish help guides for all new features and visible data when we enable them and let you know which features we are rolling out in which order in due course.



MCAS - Please note that you will not be able to set up your MCAS account until <u>2nd April</u>. Please do not try to register or set up until after this date.

Once you have signed into the MCAS App, the first thing you need to do is check your contact details are correct by selecting the 'data collection form' option and 'edit details'. If your details are not up to date, please amend them.

We will eventually be using the MCAS App as the main form of communication with parents and carers so you will start to see in app notifications in due course. In the first instance we will be using MCAS for **catering/lunches only.**

We will also be available for drop in support during the Easter holidays on Thursday 11th April between 10am-12pm. In addition we will be available for drop in support at the start of the new term on Monday 15th April 9am-10am and at 11.30am-12.30pm. No appointment is necessary and we will add more drop in times and communicate these to you if we have sufficient parental requests to do so.

From your MCAS dashboard the Dinner Money option is accessible only as a Widget. (A widget is just a mini app that displays a small amount of information on the screen at all times and interacts with the user).

The Widget displays the current Credit Balance Summary and gives the option to top up the balance.

We want to ensure our students have the best possible experience at Longbenton High School in and out of the classroom, which is why we are also **changing our catering provider to Mellors from April 2024**. You will remember that we wrote to parents before Christmas informing them of this change; it was our intention to leave North Tyneside Catering from the start of the new financial year long before they announced they would be withdrawing their service from schools. We are delighted that all of our existing kitchen staff have moved across to Mellors, so students will recognise the same team after Easter.

There are several aspects connected to the new catering service that parents need to be aware of:

- Changes to menus, including a substantially improved food offer for our students and a wider range of choices to cater for different dietary needs
- New menu tariffs (which can be found on the following pages)
- The ability to see details of what your child is purchasing and eating via the MCAS App
- Facial biometric recognition requirement for payment systems at the till
- The closure of the ParentPay system and the need for parents to set up new accounts with the MCAS App, part of Bromcom

How will my child pay for their lunch/dinner after Easter?

If you pay for school lunches/dinners

- Complete the facial recognition consent form by 25th March
- Register your MCAS account between 2nd 14th April 2024 and add credit/top up
- On 15th April, your child will pay for their meal using facial recognition at the tills
- You will be able to see your credit balance in the MCAS app

If your child is entitled to FSM (free school meals)

- Complete the facial recognition consent form by 25th March
- Register your MCAS account between 2nd 14th April 2024
- On 15th April, your child will pay for their meal using facial recognition at the tills and this will be deducted from their FSM account

You will need the MCAS App, outlined on the previous pages in this guide, to pay for lunches from 15th April 2024 onwards. The previous ParentPay system, operated by North Tyneside Council, will no longer be in operation. It is **important that you wind this account down and ensure there are no monies still in your account by Thursday 28th March.** If parents would like the credit refunding from the Council Catering Services, they will need to request this by 21 March by emailing <u>parentpay@northtyneside.gov.uk</u>. ParentPay at North Tyneside are responsible for any remaining credit balances. North Tyneside Council will issue a request for payment to parents for any debit balances due to NTC. It is important to note that Longbenton High School does not have control over the refund or collection of balances. This is the responsibility of North Tyneside Council up until 28th March.





Biometric Facial Recognition

If you wish for your child to participate with biometric facial recognition in order to speed up service at the tills, you will need to opt in using this Google Form <u>Parental Consent Form for Biometric Recognition</u> before 25th March 2024. Cunninghams, who will be providing the technology and logistics for our new till systems, will be in school on March 26th to take student photographs, so we require consent before then.

FAQS

Why are you using biometric recognition?

Biometric recognition converts physical characteristics into a unique digital signature that can be used to quickly and securely locate your child's cashless catering account. This helps speed up service and eliminates the requirement to remember a free school meals code or carry another means of payment, such as a card that can be lost or stolen.

How does it work?

When the child looks at the camera, the software reads key features and compares this against the database of registered users. When it finds a match it automatically opens their cashless catering account, allowing the operator to complete the sale. It takes seconds.

What happens when my child leaves the school?

All data will be deleted and will not be stored.

I don't wish to give permission for my child to participate with biometric recognition. Can my child still purchase school meals?

Yes, but this is limited to one till in the school and therefore may limit your child's food choices.

What if I change my mind?

If you initially opt in for your child to use biometric recognition but later change your mind, contact the school and we will remove the permission from the system, which will automatically remove any biometric data associated with your child and provide your child with an alternative method of authentication.

Can this biometric data be used by any other agency?

No, the software turns your child's physical characteristics into an encrypted string of characters known as a template (using AES 256; no fingerprint image is stored). Even if someone were to gain access to the data and break the encryption, this template does not contain enough information to reverse engineer into useable data.
