We are looking to recruit an enthusiastic and confident individual to join our team. As part of our inclusion team, you will be assigned to a particular department/s and will be responsible for supervising classes in the absence of teaching staff. The right candidate may also have their own teaching load as an Unqualified Teacher. Previous curriculum support and learning support staff have progressed on to successful teaching careers and we have a record of supporting individuals in obtaining Qualified Teacher Status through apprenticeship routes.

The main features of your work will be providing supervision cover for hour-long lessons during the school day. You will usually be used for this cover where the teacher absence is short term, either through sudden illness for which we had not planned the day before, or for planned absence where a teacher is on a course or conference. In addition, you will be required at times to support teachers if there is no cover requirement, or to accompany staff when they take groups of students out of school (for instance to theatre/gallery visits or conferences). Other duties may include covering Reset (internal isolation), small group teaching support, exam invigilation, helping teachers with preparation and production of classroom materials.
