Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome back to the new term; I hope you all had a restful half term break. Students have returned to school incredibly well; we were pleased to see them all back yesterday at LHS for these final two months of the school year.

School surveys

At Longbenton High School we are committed to building a school culture with meaning, purpose and belonging; a welcoming and inclusive environment for all our students and staff. We are currently working with two external programmes: an external charity, **Diversity Role Models** (DRM) and the Department for Education's (DfE) **Behaviour Hubs** programme to provide some external scrutiny of our systems and thinking, to network with other schools and to access support, training and resources. The Behaviour Hubs programme is open to a wide range of schools, all at different stages of their journey in terms of behaviour culture. Schools like us that join the programme self-refer, because they believe in continuous improvement and want to access information, training and learning from other schools to support that. A key element of DRM's 'Embracing Difference, Ending Bullying project' is surveying all school stakeholders to gain insights into their experiences with the school. The data collected will be integral to the project and enable Diversity Role Models to support us as a school in the development of our bespoke school action plan.

There are consequently surveys that we will be asking students and parents/carers to undertake as part of these projects.

Students in current Year 8 will be making option choices for Year 9 over the next couple of weeks. They will then choose a further three subjects from the following: Art, DT, Food Studies, Music or Drama. Punctuality & Uniform

Can I take this opportunity to remind parents and carers to support us in upholding our basic expectations regarding uniform and punctuality:

- In the summer months, school jumpers are optional; blazers are not. Coats should not be worn inside.
- Ties in house colours must be worn at all times; shirts must be tucked in.
- Shoes should be PLAIN black with no visible coloured logos or branding (eg NOT Converse trainers).
- Students should not be wearing leggings or tracksuit bottoms in place of black trousers/skirts.
- School starts at 8.35am each day including Tuesdays. The side access gate is closed at 8.35am and students are marked as late. Students **should be in their form room BY 8.35am**. Excessive lateness without good reason results in removal of privileges eg supervised lunch/break.
