Dear Parents, Carers and Students

I hope you all had a restful half term holiday and feel recharged ready for the term ahead. There are a few updates I wanted to provide particularly around staffing, Covid, exams and future dates.

Staffing Update

We have been in the process of undertaking a staffing restructure in the school which has involved some changes to senior and middle leadership posts. In addition, Karen Gammack, our existing Deputy Headteacher, is due to retire this year following two very successful years with us. She will be leaving at May half term. We have appointed two fantastic new Deputy Headteachers who are due to start at the beginning of June: Paul Atkinson (currently Assistant Headteacher at Jarrow School) and Sarah Willis (existing Assistant Headteacher). They will be responsible for Culture & Ethos and Quality of Education respectively. Other key appointments which will see a change from September 2022 are: Head of Sixth Form - Abby Potts will be taking over this role, although Ian Williams will stay on as Assistant Headteacher - and Raising Standards Leader (Year Leader) for Year 7; this will be Kat Lambert.

Covid Update

You will be aware that over half term the rules regarding Covid have been relaxed further by the government. This means that:

- → There is no longer a legal requirement for people with Covid infection to self-isolate
- → If you have any of the main symptoms of Covid or a positive test result, the public health advice is still to stay at home and avoid contact with other people.
- → Contacts are no longer required to self-isolate or advised to take daily tests, and contact tracing has ended.
- → From 21 February, staff and pupils in mainstream secondary schools will not be expected to continue taking part in regular asymptomatic testing and should follow asymptomatic testing advice for the general population.

If you have any questions regarding the changes, please just ask.

Uniform

We will be asking students, now that the weather is warmer, to stop wearing coats while in classrooms. Please ensure that your child is wearing their blazer and the correct (optional) school jumper (this is a plain black v-neck jumper); trainers if worn as shoes should be plain black without visible logos (eg Vans with large white sections are not acceptable). The wearing of coats (during covid outbreaks when we have had lots of windows open) has enabled some students to 'hide' incorrect uniform in recent months and we need to ensure that they are meeting our expectations; we need parental help in this, ensuring that your child is leaving the house in the correct items.

Ukrainian refugee appeal

We are launching a charity appeal from Monday 14 March which will run throughout the week. Our students are keen to raise awareness of the current refugee crisis and to raise some funds for the DEC (Disasters Emergency Committee <u>https://donate.redcross.org.uk/appeal/ukraine-crisis-appeal</u>) We will be selling blue/yellow ribbons (as we might for the Poppy appeal, so any donation amount will help, however small) throughout the week and holding other fundraising competitions and events. The Polish Centre in Newcastle have been inundated with item donations and have paused them for now (see story <u>here</u>), so we are not collecting physical items at this point. If you would like some advice on how to talk to your child about the war in Ukraine, there is a useful blog post <u>here</u> which has also been shared with our staff.
