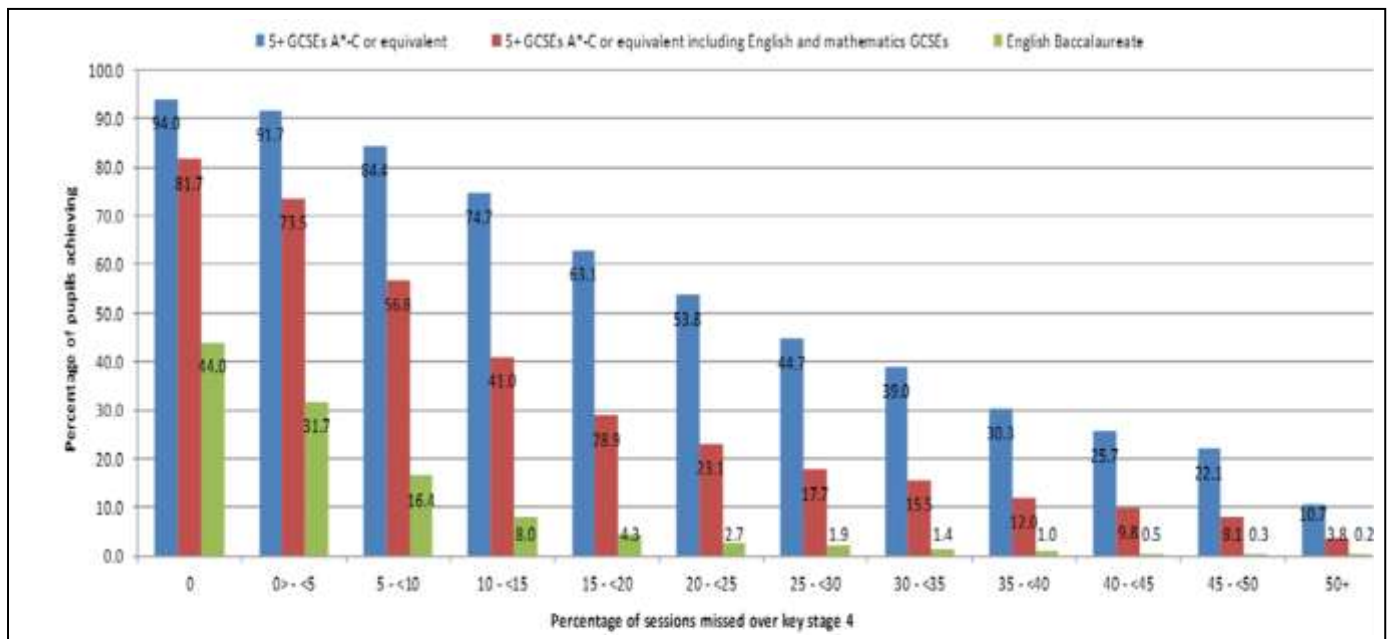


Attendance and chances for success at Key Stage 4 – Fact Sheet

Regular school attendance is important if you want your child to achieve the grades they are capable of in their GCSE examinations. The graph below shows that as attendance goes down, so do the chances of achieving those good GCSE grades.



The more days your child misses from school the less likely they are to achieve well at the end of Year 11

Lots of things can affect attendance over the year:

- 2 Weeks of holiday brings attendance down to 94.7%
- 2 Weeks holiday + 1 week sick brings attendance down to 92.2%
- 2 Weeks holiday + 2 weeks sick brings attendance down to 89.6%

Don't let them miss out - Make sure your child is in school
