You are going to do two last lessons on Hinduism. The title of today's lesson is <u>Hinduism: Rites of</u> <u>Passage</u>. Present your work however you like, answering the questions below.

- 1. What is a 'rite of passage'?
- 2. Explain at least two 'rites of passage' which all humans go through.
- 3. Explain what the word 'ashrama' means (not 'ashram', which is very similar).
- 4. Explain what the Hindu ashramas are. It will help to search things like 'Hindu life stages'.
- 5. Do you think rites of passage to mark different life stages are important? Explain your thoughts.

## Week Beginning: 1 June 2020

The title of today's lesson is <u>Hinduism: Diwali</u>. Present you work however you like, answering the questions below.

- 1. What is your favourite festival? Explain.
- 2. Why do people find festivals important? Explain. You could give examples of different festivals from around the world.
- 3. What is Diwali? Explain things such as when it takes place, what it celebrates, what people wear and eat, how people decorate their houses...
