<u>Lesson 2 – Asking questions – introducing yourself</u>

- 1. Access the lesson below on Oak Academy again https://www.thenational.academy/online-classroom/year-7/french/#subjects
- 2. Watch the video again and make a list of all of the questions in French and English i.e What's your name? = Comment t'appelles-tu? (leave 2 lines between each question.)

HINT: NOTE WORDS PHONETICALLY (how it sounds) TO HELP YOU REMEMBER HOW TO SAY THEM I.E COMMENT = "COM-ON" – this will help in lesson 3!!!

From memory try to write an answer about yourself in French – you can look again at the video to check.
i.e I'm called Joe = Je m'appelle Joe
Adapt all of these phrases into the 3rd person – to write about someone else (he / she is called etc)

<u>Lesson 3 – Interviewing yourself</u>

- 1. Use everything you have learned in lesson 1 and 2 and practice asking and answering the questions out loud in French use the video again to check how to pronounce the words or refer to your notes from lesson 2 to help you.
- 2. Ask someone to ask you the questions and try to answer from memory you could ask someone at home to help or you could call / skype / zoom / whatsapp etc someone else. Otherwise, you could record yourself asking the questions then play the question and try to answer.
- 3. CHALLENGE: record yourself answering the questions out loud in French and send it via e mail!!! I'm looking forward to hearing you all practising your French!!
