# Independent learning to be completed during school closure

## <u>History – How different was life in the Tudor times compared to our modern</u> <u>world?</u>

### Lesson 1 – How healthy were the people in the Tudor times?

## <u>Lesson 2 – What was it like to go to school in the Tudor times?</u>
