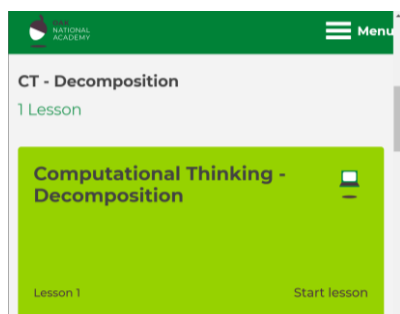

Lesson 1 Computational Thinking - Decomposition

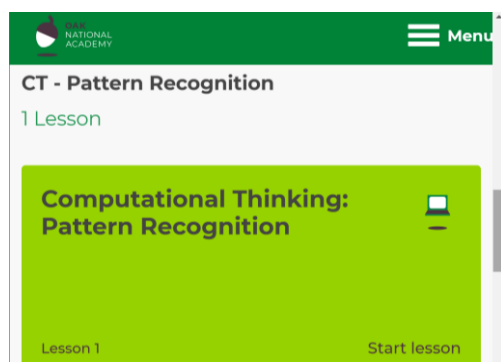
