## Further arrangements for Year 6 moving into Year 7

We wanted to write to you following our transition day to confirm some important details and advise you further of events that are happening before the end of this term and at the start of the new academic year. We do hope that, if your child attended any transition events, they enjoyed their time with us. We were particularly pleased with the way the year 6 students approached the events, engaging really well with the activities on offer. Throughout the events students were introduced to our school values, which are composed from the acronym KIDMAP - kindness, integrity, determination, manners, ambition and positivity. It was particularly encouraging to see so many students displaying these values and being a credit to you. It was also wonderful to see so many students keen to be involved in our period 6 enrichment programme.

During the full transition day students were given some important information regarding who their tutor is and house group. The latter has an implication on the colour of tie that your child will be wearing in September, students wear the colour of their house group; Dunstanburgh (green), Bamburgh (blue), Warkworth (orange) and Alnwick (purple).

Monday 15th &	<b>Uniform Shop</b> We will be running a uniform pop up shop on Monday 3-4pm and on
Tuesday 16th July	Tuesday 8.45-9.45am for any families who are interested in picking up some good quality
	pre-loved uniform. This includes PE kit, blazers, shirts and jumpers.
Wednesday 4th September	Starting High School - Year 7 only in school:
September	Students need to arrive at school at 8.45 a.m. in full uniform; they will not need to bring in any PE kit on their first day. Students will start the day in tutor groups and will spend some time with their new class. They will be issued with their timetable and will then follow this to experience four lessons during the school day. They will finish at the usual time of 3.15pm.
	<b>Parents are invited into school from 2.30pm until approx. 3.15pm</b> to meet the Senior Leadership Team and other key staff, have some light refreshments to 'celebrate' their child's first day at high school and collect students when they finish school.
Thursday 5th September	Students will arrive to begin a normal school day at 8.45am They will experience five lessons and finish at 3.15pm.
Friday 6th September	All other year groups return to school.
September	1:1 meetings with form tutors. This will be an opportunity for parents and students to have a 1:1 meeting with the form tutor to discuss how students have settled at high school. Details to follow in the new term.
