I am pleased to inform you that the school has secured a place on the Department for Education's Behaviour Hubs programme. This initiative was launched by the DfE three years ago. The purpose of the programme is to partner schools to help each other to improve behaviour. You will be aware of the improvements we have made over the last 12 months in the conduct of our students and the programme represents a new chapter on this journey.

The first step is a benchmarking process. In order to achieve this an external organisation undertakes a review of the student's perspective of behaviour in the school.
