Re: New COVID-19 Email Address

You will no doubt be aware, from the national media and the school's own experience yesterday, that schools are having to react extremely quickly to any confirmed cases of coronavirus within their settings.

Whilst the school currently has no confirmed cases of coronavirus, in the event a learner does test positive for coronavirus it is vitally important that families let school know immediately so that school can liaise with Public Health and isolate learners and staff who have been in contact with the confirmed case.

The email will be checked throughout the school day and out of hours (in the evenings and over the weekend) so that the school is best placed to respond to any confirmed cases.
