Year 10 Mock Exams

I hope you are well. I am just getting in touch to share with you information about the Year 10 mock examinations.

Our Year 10 students will have a mock examination period between Friday 25th June and Wednesday 30th June for EBacc subjects. This examination period is an important opportunity for students to develop their independent study skills and to experience examinations in the sports hall setting. The examinations will also provide important information for both students and teachers on areas of specifications where learners are already very successful, and areas to focus on for further improvements. A copy of the examination timetable can be found below for your information.

Subject teachers will be providing students with guidance on the areas of content to be revising for these examinations, along with revision material. If you have any subject specific queries, please contact your child's teacher in the first instance.

Students who may be entitled to examination access arrangements will be assessed for these in the weeks before the mock examination period, and any awarded access arrangements will be provided during this mock examination period, this will help students to get used to completing their assessments with their access arrangements in place.

Results from these assessments will be released in the week before the summer holidays, along with some revision material so that students can do some additional preparation to be ready for the start of Year 11 in September.
