Parents Information Event and Mock Exam Timetable

Now that we have completed our first half term of the school year, I just thought I would get in touch to share some important information for this half term.

Following our first parents information event in September, as we approach the EBacc December mock exams (30th November – 4th December) I thought you may find it helpful if our EBacc curriculum leaders (English, maths, science, humanities and MFL) shared some subject specific information with you to enable you to effectively assist your child at home with their exam preparations. We will also share some information on effective overall revision strategies and some strategies on how to support your child through the stress that they may experience related to exam periods.

Again, to provide you with this update, in other circumstances I would invite you into school for a presentation, however this is not possible at this point in time. Therefore the presentation will be via Teams Live Events. You will be able to type any questions you have into the Q and A function of Teams and we will respond to as many questions as we can. This presentation will be at 5pm on Thursday 12th November and the link for the presentation is here. If you are not available at this time, the recording of the presentation will be available through the same link.

Parents evening is calendared for Thursday 19th November and this will provide you with an opportunity to speak to your child's individual subject teachers. Due to the current context this will be a virtual event and Dr Glancey will be sending you further details about this. As you will know from the parent information event the subject specific details about exam boards, course structure and subject specific exam tips, it means the focus of the parents evening can just be on information specific to your child. As always, the parents evening slots are only 5 minutes so if a longer conversation is needed a follow up phone call will need to be organised.

The mock exam timetable and seating plan numbers will shortly be available on INSIGHT for parents and learners to access, a copy of the timetable is also attached. I hope that you will be able to join us for the GCSE information presentation, and if there is anything else I can be of help with, please do not hesitate to get in touch.
