- Recite numbers to 5

Physical Development

- Take part in group activities that they make up themselves, or in teams e.g. following the leader
- Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold for a game like musical statues
- Use one-handed tools
- Dance (Tuesday) – travelling, balance and shapes; repeat sequences
- Gymnastics (Wednesday) – shapes, balances and jumps; repeat actions

- Develop confidence in speaking (nativity)
- Join in with games to make new friendships
- Select & use resources, with help when needed
- Negotiate sharing and solve conflicts with words
