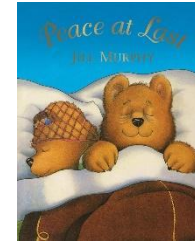
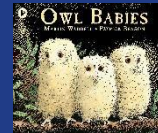
Self-regulation and my feelings

Expressive Art and Design
