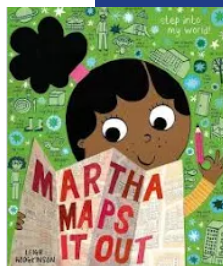

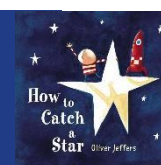
Managing self – My well being
