

## Mathematics

- Begin to sort objects according to colour, size or shape
- Show the right number of objects to match the numeral for 1 and 2
- Subitise small groups of objects
- Recite numbers to 5
- Begin to show 'finger numbers' up to 5 when joining number songs and rhymes
- Make comparisons between objects relating to size and length.

## Communication & Language

- Be able to talk about familiar books
- Sit and listen to a story
- Answer simple question about what they have heard
- Speak in simple sentences
- Weekly sharing of news
- Listening games
- Learn new vocabulary

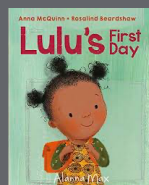

## Literacy

- Daily story time
- Sound discrimination games
- Mark-making
- Recognising names
- Nursery Rhymes & Traditional Tales
- SignAlong sign language
- Children join in with the rhyme, rhythm and repetition of the stories they hear
- Discuss key vocabulary linked to pictures



## Understanding the World

- Share photos of family and when the children were babies; talk about what is the same/different
- Begin to develop positive attitudes about the differences between people

## Expressive Art & Design

- Paint a self-portrait from a photograph of themselves
- Begin to explore choosing & mixing colours
- Take part in simple pretend play

## Daily Enhancements

Monday – Motor Skills  
Tuesday – Dance  
Wednesday – Gymnastics  
Thursday – Food Preparation  
Friday – Gardening / Yoga

## Physical Development

- Take part in group activities that they make up themselves, or in teams e.g. following the leader
- Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold for a game like musical statues
- Use one-handed tools
- Dance (Tuesday)
- Gymnastics (Wednesday)

## Personal, Social, & Emotional Development

- Develop confidence as settling in
- Join in with games to make new friends
- Select & use resources, with help when needed
- Listen to stories about friendship & talk about what it means to be a friend.
