N	The formal teaching of a foreign language begins at Key Stage 2, in line with the national curriculum. Children are given a gradual introduction to languages during their first years of schooling. In the EYFS children may listen to and learn songs, stories and games. Teachers will decide when and what is appropriate based on topics and themes. Key Stage 1 will continue this approach and will introduce foreign languages through registration activities, topic links, celebration days, festivals and world events. The acquisition of language, as taught through Read Write Inc and Pathways to Write is an important stepping stone in preparing to learn Spanish from Year 3 onwards.
