Count to and across ten, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number.

Count, read and write numbers to ten in numerals.

Given a number, identify one more and one less.

Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representation.

Compare numbers using < > and =

Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction and (=) signs.
