Mathematics



Place value, addition and subtraction

- counting, reading, writing and comparing numbers to 100, and using symbols $<$ $>$ $=$
- partitioning numbers in different ways
- recognising the value of each digit in a two digit number
- add and subtract using numbers to 20, becoming increasingly fluent in deriving addition and subtraction facts, including the inverse
- use addition and subtraction facts to solve problems
