Melody 	Notes that are played one after the other to make a tune (a melody).	Dynamics 	Describes how loudly or quietly the music is being played.	
Compose 	To write or create (a work of art, especially music or poetry).	Timbre 	The quality or colour of sound that makes one voice or instrument different from another.	
Improvise 	The art of composing music while performing it, without the help of a written score.	Texture 	Describes the layers of sound in music interact with each other.	
Cover 	A version of a song performed by someone other than the original artist. It might sound a bit or very different from the original.	Structure 	How the sections of music are organised to create the whole piece.	
Pulse 	A steady beat like a ticking clock or your heartbeat	Dimensions of Music 	Include pitch, duration, dynamics, tempo, timbre, texture, structure and how they all link together in music.	
Rhythm  	The pattern of musical movement through time formed by a series of notes differing in duration and stress.	Ostinato/ Phrases 	A repeating pattern of of 3-5 notes.	
Pitch 	How high or low a musical sound is.	Unison 	Everyone plays or sings the same thing at the same time.	
Tempo 	Describes how fast or slowly the music is played.	Urban Gospel	It is a modern form of Christian music and provides a Christian alternative to mainstream secular music. Musically, it follows the trends in secular urban contemporary music.
