Humanism

Humanism is a non-religious belief.

Christianity

The religion based on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ, or its beliefs and practices. Founded in the **1st Century CE**

Hinduism

Hinduism is an Indian religion and way of life. Founded between **2300 BCE to 1500 BCE**

Judaism

The religion of the Jewish people. Founded between **600 BCE to 500 BCE**

Islam

The religion of the Muslims, a faith revealed through Muhammad as the Prophet of Allah. Founded in the **7th Century CE**

Sikhism

A religion founded in Punjab in the **15th Century CE** by Guru Nanak.

Quick Facts



There are multiple creation stories all around the world.

Humanists believe that science provides the best explanation for the existence of the universe and life on earth – nothing was created by God, but by The Big Bang Theory.

Christians believe that the world was created by God in seven days:

- One the first day God created night and day.
- On the second day he created the sky.
- On the third day God created the land, seas and bear fruits and grain.
- On the fourth day God separated the day and night by creating the sun and moon.
- On the fifth day God created living things to fill the seas and skies.
- On the sixth day God created humans and beasts to roam the lands.
- On the seventh day God had finished creating the world and so he rested.

Judaism and Islamic faiths have similar creation stories to that of the Christians, but with varying teachings.

Sikhs believe that Waheguru created the universe, the world and every life form within it.

Hindus believe that Brahma, Lord Vishnu's servant, created the world.
