Jesus (7-2 BCE to 30-33 CE), is referred to as Jesus of Nazareth or Jesus Christ, he is the central figure of Christianity and also the founder of it.

Jesus, was born in Bethlehem, which is in Israel, in a stable to his mother Mary, also known as the Virgin Mary.

Jesus was a Jewish rabbi, who preached his message orally and is reported as performing healing and miracles. Jesus' main message was that we should love: love God and love our fellow human beings.

In his life and teachings, Jesus showed a particular concern for the poor, the sick, the disadvantaged and social outcasts.

Jesus was baptised by John the Baptist in the River Jordan and saw the spirit of God.

Jesus had 12 disciples, who were devoted in helping Jesus to spread the word of God. They were fishermen, a taxman as well as a thief. One of them would one day betray Jesus.
