Mathematics:

In Maths, we will be focusing on place value-looking at numbers up to 1,000,000 and recognising each of these in a place value chart. We will then use this knowledge to look at adding and subtracting numbers, using written methods to support our learning. As the term progresses, we will look at multiplication and division and then with this knowledge begin to look at fractions.

English:

This term in English, we are exploring the traditional tale of Hansel and Gretel. Children are developing their descriptive writing skills by creating a detailed setting description. They will also retell the story in their own words, focusing on structure, vocabulary and creativity.

Computing:

This term in computing we are looking at video production, the children will look at filming, angles and editing to create their own podcast/video.

History / Geography:

In History, we will be investigating the world of The Tudors, we will be deep diving into Henry VIII and the influence he had on England today.

In Geography we focusing on Europe, we will be investigating all about the countries, populations and structures that are in Europe!

Science:
