Today the Prime Minister - Rishi Sunak - is in charge of government. He is Prime Minister of the United Kingdom and has been leader of the Conservative Party since 24th October 2022.

The Prime Minister has regular meetings with the **King** to tell him about the discussions of the Cabinet.

Every 5 years, the Prime Minister calls a general election.

The majority of politicians belong to a political party. The political party that wins the majority of the seats forms the government. The leader of that political party becomes the Prime Minister.

Today, the **Prime Minister** is in charge of the government. They make decisions for our country and they live at 10 **Downing Street.**




Elected MP's
