Plants



Living things usually rooted in the ground or living in water.

Trees



A tall plant with a trunk and branches made of wood.

Deciduous



Deciduous trees lose their leaves in the autumn.

Evergreen



Evergreen trees keep their leaves year-round.

Trunk



Give the tree its shape, support and holds it up.

Flowering



Plants that produce flowers, fruits and seeds.

Root



Roots grow underground to help keep the plant from falling over

Stem



The main structure of a plant.

Leaves



Collects energy from the sun and makes food for the plant.

Flowers



The part of a plant that has petals and that makes fruit or seeds
