

Year 11 Trial Examinations: December 2024

Examinations requiring students to be examined individually will be given individual time slots by their subject teachers. This includes some Music and Modern Foreign Language exams.

For all morning exams, students must line up in tutor groups outside Geography at 8.40am and you will be registered and either escorted down for the large exams (English, maths, science and history) or will be sent to the PE corridor by your tutor.

For exams taking place at 11:15am or 1:55pm, please line up in tutor groups outside Geography for English, maths, science and history exams, otherwise please come straight down to the PE corridor.

You must enter the PE corridor in silence and remain in silence until you leave the PE corridor. If you have a question please raise your hand and a member of staff will assist you.

You will need to bring with you the following equipment to every exam;

- Black pens (at least 2)
- HB pencils (at least 2)
- Protractor
- Compass
- Rubber
- Ruler
- Calculator (no lid)
- If using a pencil case it must be a clear one.
- Water bottle (clear no labels)

You are only allowed items that are listed above with you during the exam. You must not bring mobile telephones, watches or any smart devices into the exam hall.
