Dear Parents, Carers and members of our local community,

Re: Academy Consultation – Lowerplace Primary School and Hollingworth Learning Trust

I am writing to inform you that the Governing Board of Lowerplace Primary School has begun a formal consultation on the proposal for our school to join Hollingworth Learning Trust, a Multi-academy trust (MAT).

For over the last 18 months, we have been working closely with Hollingworth Learning Trust under an Affiliate Programme, along with several other Rochdale Primary Schools. This has been a highly successful and productive period, built on a shared ethos, vision, strong communication, and a clear understanding of what we want for our pupils and school communities whilst ensuring the very best academic and personal outcomes for all of our children. During this time, Lowerplace Governors and staff have also met with members of the Trust and visited the trust schools, to understand how the partnership could continue to support our long-term development.

I want to reassure you that Lowerplace Primary School will continue to retain its autonomy, identity and staff team, all of which are extremely important to us and remain at the heart of our decision-making.

Benefits we believe membership of Hollingworth Learning Trust would bring include:

- Closer collaborative working between strong educational institutions and a skilled Trust team, enabling staff to share expertise and further raise standards for all our children.
- Securing best value for money on products and services, achieving greater economies of scale so that more of our funding can be directed into classrooms and curriculum support.
- Expert and effective support from the Trust's central teams at a time when Local Authority services and capacity are increasingly limited due to budget pressures.
- Retaining our identity and autonomy, ensuring the nature, character, and effectiveness of our school remains unchanged.
- Increased opportunities for the Trust to apply for grants and funding streams that are not available to schools maintained by the Local Authority.
- Greater opportunities for collaborative working with a wide range of schools in other Trusts and Local Authority areas, strengthening professional development and improving educational outcomes for all local children.



The Hollingworth Learning Trust, a multi-academy trust (MAT) currently consists of:

- Hollingworth Academy
- Newhouse Academy
- Heap Bridge Village Primary School

Consultation Process:

The consultation will begin on Monday 5th January 2026 and will close on Friday 23rd January 2026.
