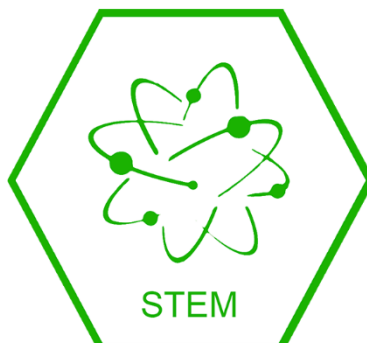

This is the history revision timetable for year 11. The revision takes place after school from 3-4pm. The topics that staff are revising will be on their mock exam papers.

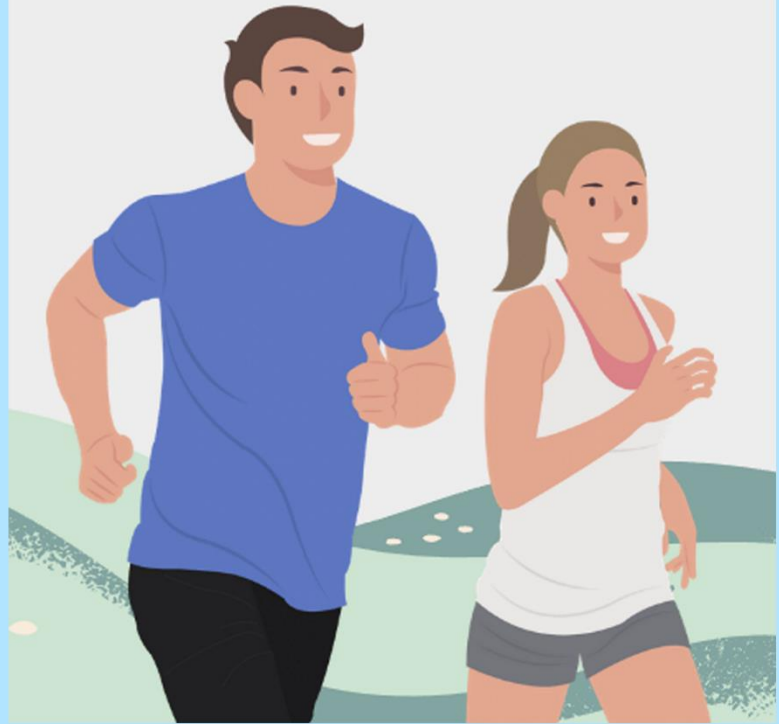

LSA Eco-Council

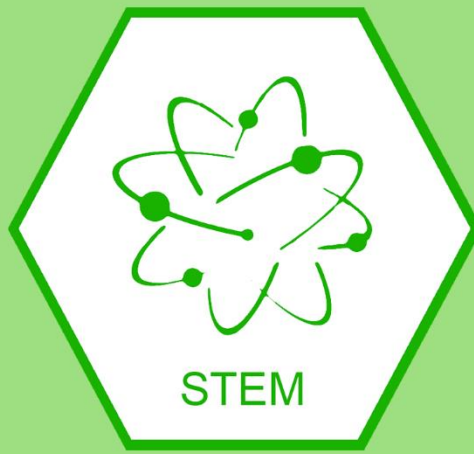
Our aims this academic year:
