Dear Parents and Carers

I am delighted to share some further details about the proposed redevelopment of the school site. Following months of meetings, the final plans about how the site will eventually look are about to be submitted to the local authority for planning approval. As part of this, local residents will receive information about the site.

This particular project is undoubtedly complex due to the need to maintain a fully functioning school, whilst the new building is built. I therefore want to take this opportunity to reassure parents and students that we are already working on detailed plans and proposals to ensure that the school experience for the children on site will not be impacted. There will be a lot more detail to follow, but the building company are highly experienced at working on school sites and will be explaining more about how we work together. This will include the health and safety of a site as well as the limitations of works around the exam seasons. LSA will continue to operate to the highest standards during this period of development.
