I realise that we cannot cover everything and there will always be questions. I would ask that you watch the video and read the guidance to ensure your child is confident about the return to full time, face-to-face teaching. If after this, you are still worried, please let us know.

Whilst year 10 and 11 are coming on to site this week for their initial LFD tests, the majority of student will be back on site throughout the week beginning 8th March. Please can I ask families to check student timetables on SatchelOne and ensure we are ready to go to the first period on the day that your child returns to full time face-to-face teaching. The teachers in these lessons will run through some basic expectations and ensure some consistent messages are communicated across the school.

For all online learning during the week beginning 8th March, we will be reverting to the school times that were in place before Christmas. These times will be for students to structure their day as there will be limited opportunities for live teaching due to staff being required in school and the disruption caused by LFD tests.

As we hopefully reach the end of emergency measures, I look forward to writing home about the many wonderful things that are happening at school, sharing the good news of a brilliant group of students and teachers.
