## Lytham St Annes High School

ENGIE welcomes you to newsletter 2 which brings you up to date on how the project is progressing. As you are aware ENGIE have now commenced work at Lytham St Annes High School on behalf of Lancashire County Council.

The new building will be a single storey steel frame with a brick façade which will contain state of the art teaching areas, wash rooms and prep rooms.

There will be an element of refurbishment works to some of the existing school buildings. All work is expected to be finished for the beginning of September 2020.

**Phase 1** - The site set up and initial soft stripping & demolition is now complete.

**Phase 2** - The construction of the new state of the art technology facility commenced in September 2019 and will be ready for the new academic year in September 2020. As you can see work is now underway with the steel frame being erected, this should be complete for Christmas.

**Phase 3** - The refurbishment to key areas of the school will progress through the main programme of works and be completed for September 2020, the first phase of this will be handed over in early January.

Site Working Hours: Normal working hours are 7.30am to 5.30pm but due to the nature of the build and the time restraints there will be an element of evening & weekend works.

Deliveries: There will be no deliveries between 08.15am & 09.15am and between 14.45pm & 15.30pm due to school drop off and collection times.

Security cameras are now in place on site.
