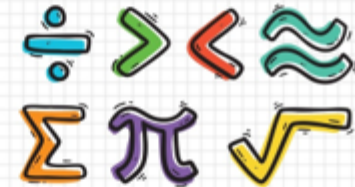
## Are you interested in becoming a Maths Leader?

This is a great opportunity to develop leadership skills, build confidence, and support others in their learning. This role would also provide valuable experience to support your Prefect application



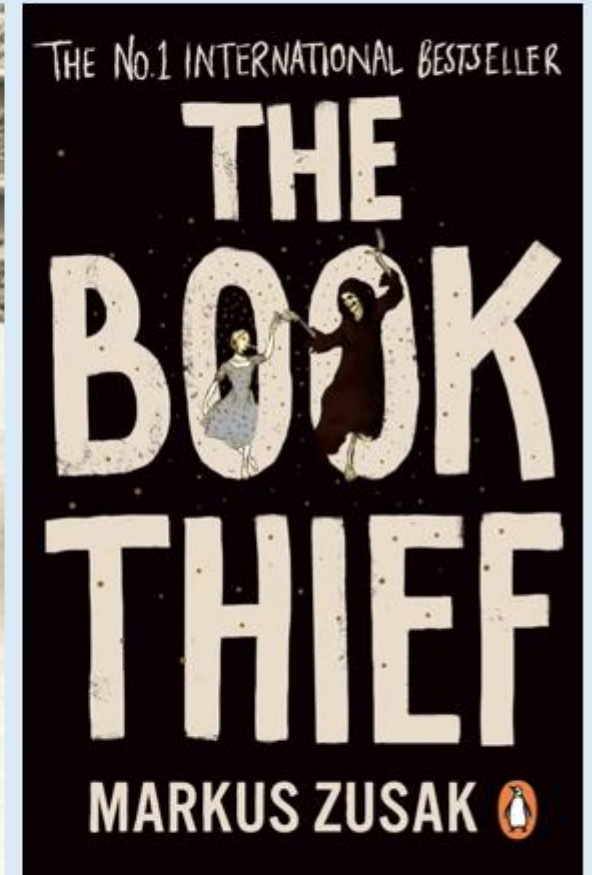
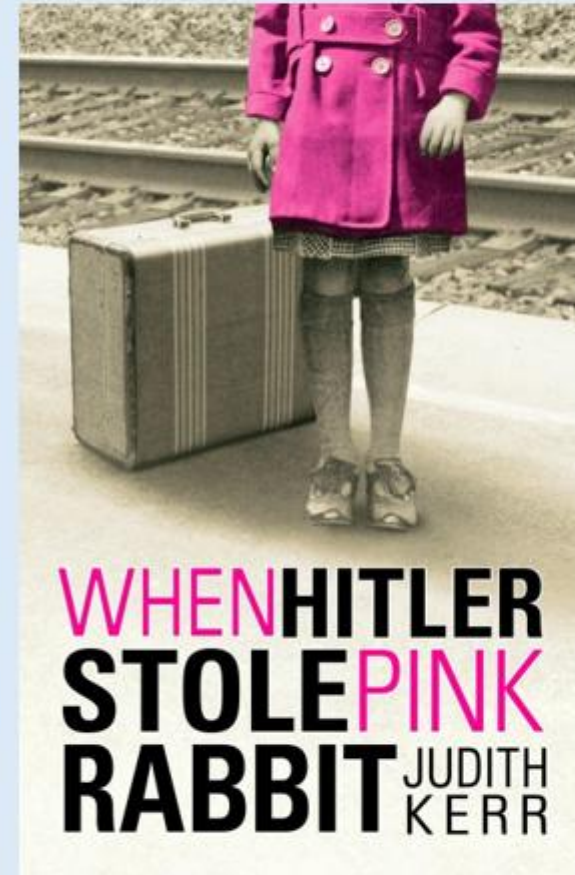
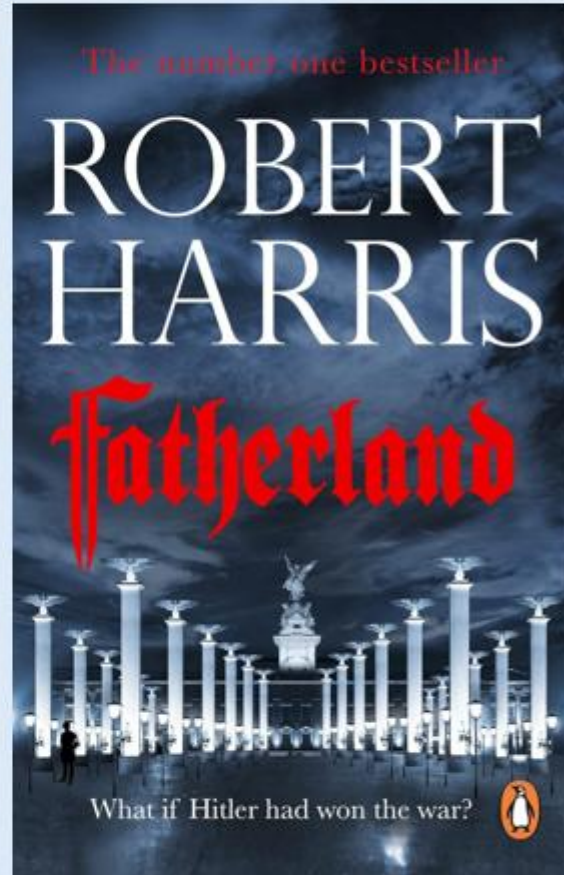
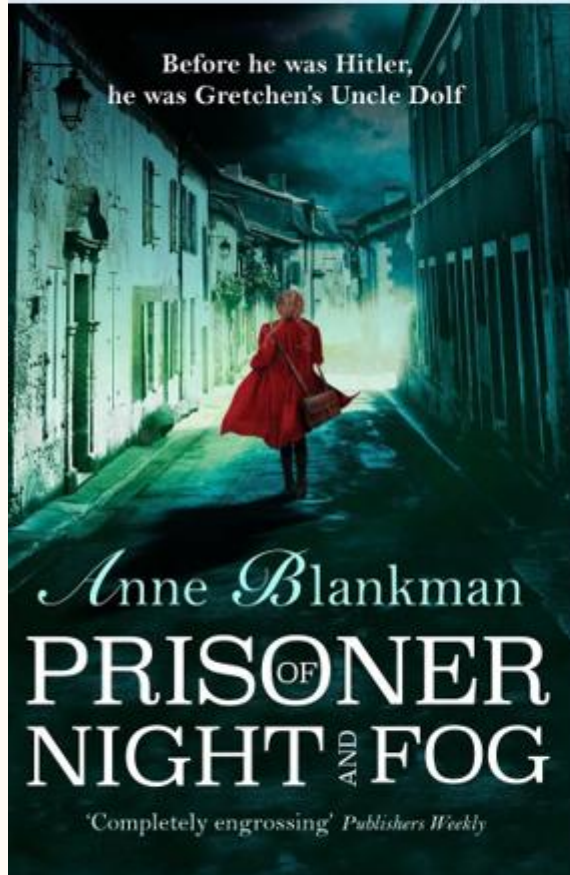
**Responsibilities may include:**
