Don't miss out — once the 80 places are gone, they're gone!



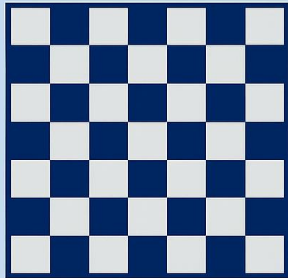
