Guitar Club


If you've always wanted to have a go at the guitar but never had the chance then Guitar Club is for you.

housed in a **laser-cut wooden box**

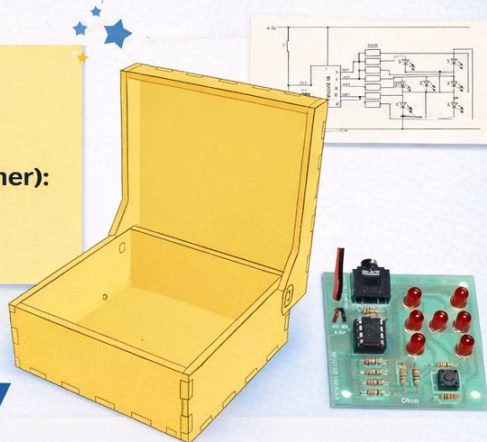
