Give your photograph a name and include the location it was taken.

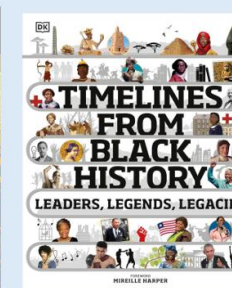
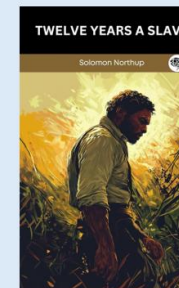
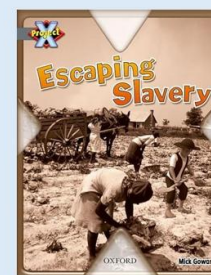
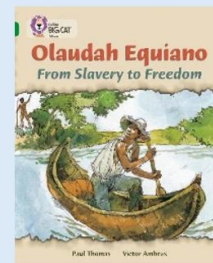
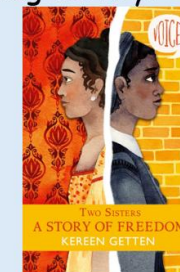
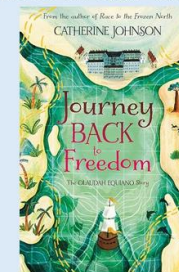
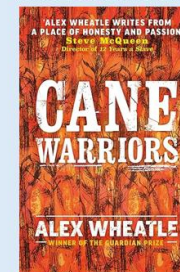
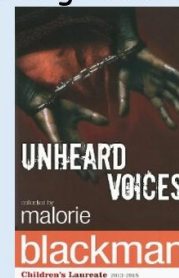
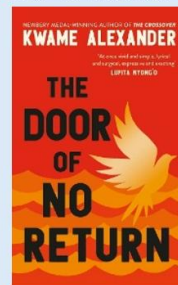
