- White polo shirt
- Navy V-necked jumper or cardigan with school logo
- Grey trousers, pinafore dress or skirt (please note leggings or jeans are not to be worn in place of trousers)
- Navy fleece with school logo (optional only available from Schoolwear Direct)
- Black, sturdy shoes (no trainers or multi-coloured shoes)
- Grey, black or white socks or grey or black tights
- Summer navy and white checked dresses or grey shorts
- Long hair should be tied up and no extreme haircuts
- Wrist watches are allowed but we do not allow smart watches
- Strictly no jewellery, nail varnish or make-up (except plain ear studs which must be removed for PE)
