We expect our Spectators/Parents to;

- Remain within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- Encourage your children to respect the opposition & officials.

We expect our members of staff to;

- Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour from your children.
- Show respect & place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each child above everything, including winning.
- Cooperate with members of staff from other schools to ensure the children are provided a positive experience.
- Support the event organiser with the smooth running of each event, with any questions being directed to them.
- Read the event details/rules to ensure your children are prepared to take part in each event & engage with pre-event briefing.
- Encourage your children to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.

We expect our Sport Leaders to;

- Support the children at all times ensuring a fair and consistent approach.
- Set a good example by being a positive role model and mirroring the excellent behaviour we expect from the children at LASP events.
- Communicate effectively to ensure children and members of staff understand your instructions / decisions.
- Avoid any negative confrontations with children/ adults, seek support from LASP coordinator. (Mr Jones)
- Be confident, encouraging and positive at ALL times to ensure an enjoyable experience for the children at each event.
