We are trialling using a few, shorter surveys this year to gain feedback over a wider range of dates and to make the surveys more accessible.

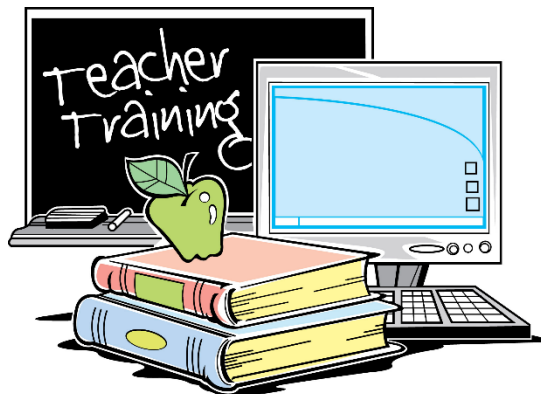


INSED 2026-2027
