

Maths

The children will be revising number bonds to 10 and 20, and will be recapping on the 2, 5, 10 times tables before moving onto the 3, 4, and 8 times tables.

The children will then be looking at place value of numbers up to 1000 and learn to use the column method for addition and subtraction

The children will be using cubes, base 10 and other manipulatives to explore and compare numbers.

English

We will be looking at the following texts over the half term during our reading into writing sessions:

The Life Story of Jesse Owens

During shared and guided reading we will be reading Fantastic Mr Fox by Roald Dahl and developing our comprehension skills.

Art

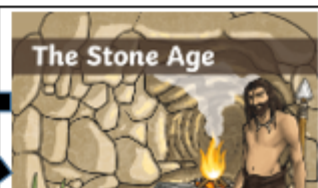

Computing

Computing Systems and Networks.

During our computing sessions we will develop our understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs.

History/Geography

The Children will be learning about STONE AGE, BRONZE AGE Life & IRON AGE and look at how their lives compared and differed to ours today.

French: We will begin with simple introductions and classroom instructions as well as finding out a little about France.

Music: We will be doing a Unit on Dorset Music Online called Let Your Spirit Fly, singing R&B, playing along in time on glockenspiels and chime bars.

Science

We will be focusing on humans. We will learn about nutrition, skeletons and how muscles support us.

RE
