

## Maths

This term we will be teaching the column method of subtraction. As well as focussing on the 2, 4 and 8 times tables and related division facts. The children learn about unit fractions, as part of a whole and will compare and order unit fractions.

The children will need to continue to learn and practice times tables to improve confidence and fluency.

## English

This half term we will be reading *The Cloud Tea Monkeys* by Mal Peet and *Elspeth Graham Flotsam* by David Wiesner. We will learn skills to support the children in writing a non-chronological report, a diary entry and narrative based on Flotsam.

We will continue to master our reading comprehension and spelling skills.

## DT

We will be focussing on food this term, looking at foods and teas from around the world. The children will get the opportunity to become tea tasting sommeliers, trying teas from around the world.

The children will design and make a box for their uniquely designed tea.

## Computing

During our computing lessons this half term the children will develop their understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one.

## Geography

This term we will be learning about our blue planet. We will be looking at the oceans and how they are under threat through pollution and over fishing. We will be finding out how we can protect our planet.

## French

This term the children will learn the days on the week and the months of the year and learn the different seasons in French. The children will also learn how to say when their birthday is. They will also consolidate counting to 20

## Science

Our topic is **FORCES & MAGNETS**: Comparing forces on varied surfaces, between objects and magnetic properties.

**Music**: The children will be listening at musical styles like reggae and will be playing and singing songs from other genres.

## RE

The children will explore the significance of Good Friday, reflecting on its meaning in the context of salvation and why it is considered "good."

## PSHE

The unit is 'Rights and Responsibilities'. The children will be learning about the community they live in and how they can contribute. The children will discuss money, how they earn it and saving and spending.

## PE

This term we will be learning about different athletic sports and skills. We will also be looking at orienteering and working as a team to solve problems.
